

## Timeliness of Prenatal Care

**The Timeliness of Prenatal Care measure is a Quality Incentive Measure.**

**Measure Description:** Percentage of pregnant women who received a prenatal care visit within the first trimester or within 42 days of enrollment in WOA. H.

### Measure Specifications

**Data:** Claims data and Chart Review

**Benchmark:** 91.7%

**Denominator:** All live birth deliveries from November 6, 2017 through November 5, 2018 for WOA. H members who also meet the continuous enrollment criteria. OHA will identify the live birth deliveries from claims data and provide WOA. H with a sample for chart review.

**Continuous Enrollment Criteria:** 43 days prior to the delivery date through 56 days after the delivery date.

**Numerator:** A prenatal visit in the first trimester or within 42 days of enrollment in WOA. H.

## Postpartum Care

**The Postpartum Care measure is not incentivized, but is reported publicly as a state performance measure.**

**Measure Description:** Percentage of women with a postpartum care visit on or between 21 and 56 days after delivery.

**Benchmark:** 69.4%

**Denominator:** Same as for Prenatal Care, above.

**Numerator:** A postpartum visit for a pelvic exam or postpartum care on or between 21 and 56 days after delivery.

**Continuous enrollment criteria:** 43 days prior to the Estimated Date of Delivery (EDD) through 56 days after EDD.

Bill stand-alone code 0500F on the date of initial OB care, this will trigger the numerator, providing claims data and reducing chart review burden.
