OHSU <b>“You are the Key”</b> study: This study is a joint effort with OHA and Oregon Health Sciences University to understand the amount of COVID-19 that is in the state. Starting May 11<sup>th</sup>, over 100,000 people will be contacted throughout the state to participate. This is voluntary and is not required. If contacted, you would be asked to monitor your symptoms and give that information to the OHSU study officials. If you have significant symptoms, you may be asked to get a test for COVID-19.
