<p>4.0 Advanced Health Updates</p>	<p>Telehealth/2019 Metrics-</p> <p>Lisa Castle, Quality Improvement Specialist from Advanced Health gave a presentation on the recent Request For Proposals (RFPs) for Telehealth services between Coos and Curry Counties. Lisa shared the process that was rolled out to providers and then announced the awardees and their projects and funding amounts. Lisa also reviewed the 2019 incentive metrics and how Advanced Health scored in each area. (full PowerPoint presentation available upon request to bonnie.ell@advancedhealth.com).</p> <p>Beth Barker-Hidalgo inquired as to why there were no telehealth awards given to Curry providers. Lisa notified us</p>		



	<p>that no providers from Curry applied for the grants. Anna Marie Curtis from Coastal Home Health & Hospice mentioned that she was unaware of the RFPs and they are trying to develop their telehealth program, but lack experience in grant writing. In response to this, Lisa Castle has drafted a sample telehealth grant application to be shared in Curry.</p> <p>Ben Messner, CEO of Advanced Health also spoke to the telehealth grants and to the commitment of Advanced Health at this time to help support health systems in both Coos and Curry Counties during the pandemic.</p> <p>Bonnie Ell asked if a second round of telehealth funding might be possible for Curry and Ben said that might be a possibility. Bonnie also announced that Advanced Health plans to sponsor the Brookings swimming pool again for free family Saturday swimming. Call 541-469-4711 to reserve a spot for your family.</p> <p>Brookings Harbor Food Bank is renting Bob the Bus from the Brookings Harbor School District and will use it to distribute snack packs in the community on Wednesdays State Resource card- attached- will be included in activity bags throughout the county.</p> <p>Bonnie Ell announced the CHIP funding process:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - We plan to have a final application out for Curry by 7/6. - Then applications will be due for Curry by 8/7 for the first round of funding. - CAC Members review applications at the CAC meetings in August, October, and December as long as there are still funds available. - At our July Curry CAC meeting, we can review the scoring tool and discuss the scoring and award process in more detail in preparation for the August meeting. - We have \$37,500 in funds for the Curry CAC to award through the end of the year. <p>Bonnie Ell announced the next CHIP Coalition meeting on Aug. 5th @ 2 pm via Zoom.</p>
