“Our current program allows for medical staff and other first responders to seek support at their choice of providers and we act as a third party payer, either paying the provider directly for services or covering the costs of co-pays and/or deductibles. We, and SAMHSA, realize that there are instances where an employee may be unwilling or unable to access their employer sponsored “in-network” providers; so we set up our program to bridge that gap. Also, while the service is confidential, SAMHSA does require us to collect Government Performance and Results Act (GPRA) data at intake with a follow up about three months later. This data is reported back to SAMHSA anonymously through their secure web portal.”
