<p>CHIP Update</p>	<p>Brookings CORE - Dianna Cooper</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Update CAC on funding <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Used for communications and outreach -purchased items. o Peer house program – Walk in services – hygiene bags and clothing closet. o 674 people visited the Peer house program – o 169 /month. First quarter 140 hygiene bags over 400 pieces of clothing in the first quarter. o The numbers are getting bigger each month. o There has been a lot of outreaches in the community and getting the word out. Over 200 visitors in April – the most ever o Now have an office manager who is also a peer support specialist, to help people quickly. And help with last minute stuff. - Resource Navigation program. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Case management – have funding this is appointment based. o Sit down and work out your goals. o Funding available for helping with goal-related items. ID, Gas, etc. - Winter warming - Project turnkey – working with Oasis, coming in late 2023. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Have one room set up for high need individual – o Case manager and peer support on site. o 2 rooms to be used and general medical need. - Street medicine program – mobile medical <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o THW billing will be available. o Grant applications out to the state to potentially partner for this program. o Get a mobile van for the clinic and hire a provider. o One case manager for this program. - Working on a marketing plan for monthly updates and information sharing <p>ODHS is collocating on Mondays at the Center– Kerri Fox as a case worker.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - CBO room available for organizations to help at CORE response. <p>Efforts being made for a mobile shower unit.
