HRSN Climate Services benefit is LIVE!

Do you have a patient who could qualify?

Is your patient a member of any of these populations?

- Homeless or at risk of homelessness
- Discharged from adult BH residential
- Child-welfare involved
- Transitioning to dual status
- Released from Incarceration

Providers are encouraged to coordinate with clinic care management teams if you have a patient that could be eligible.

- 4 HRSN climate services referrals received
- 100% of which were member self referrals
